Individually a party and collectively parties to this Memorandum.

The parties believe that:

1. Mutual benefit can be derived from scholarly interaction, cultural interchange, cooperative research and other forms of academic collaboration.
2. The parties regard the following areas of cooperation as desirable and feasible:
 - (i) Exchange of students and academic staff members;
 - (ii) Establishment of dual or joint degree programs for both undergraduates (2+2) and graduates (1+1+);
 - (iii) Collaboration of students and academic staff training;
 - (iv) Mutual assistance and co-organization in seminars, conferences, and workshops;
 - (v) Joint-research and exchange of academic publication materials or other information;
 - (vi) Co-operation in training projects for specified areas of development; and
 - (vii) Opportunities for other forms of co-operation, such as the delivery of award and non-award courses, scholarships of master and doctoral program, etc.
3. The terms of specific areas of cooperation shall be further considered and agreed upon in writing by the parties prior to the initiation of any particular activity.
4. Any specific program will be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds and approval of both parties.
5. The parties agree that this Memorandum of Understanding is not a formal legal agreement giving rise to any legal relationship, rights, duties or consequences, but it is only a definite expression and record of the purpose of the parties to which the parties are bound in honor only.
6. This Memorandum of Understanding will be effective when both parties have signed this Memorandum and shall remain in force until terminated by either party giving the other party six month notice in advance.
